All Fur Fun Policies

First and foremost our goal here at All Fur Fun (AFF) is to ensure that **all dogs and their handlers** have a great time and succeed in all they do! In order to ensure this we ask that **everyone** read through and keep in mind the policies we have set in place here.

- **Thank you for coming!** We're always glad to see you and your pooch, but do us a favor and please let us know you're here when you are. If no one is in the front office we're usually around tending to dogs or clients.
- **Up-to-date Rabies** are required for participation in our classes. Titers are accepted in lieu of vaccinations.
- **Payments** for classes can be made online or at the front desk via cash, check (payable to AFF), or credit card
- **Potty your dog** prior to entering the building. We realize accidents happen, trust us. But it's up to you to make sure that your dog is relieved. We provide bags for your use outside and have all of the materials for cleaning up any indoor accidents. Bear in mind that if your dog (6 months and older) has a potty accident inside there is a \$1 "oops!" fee payable in cash. If you do not have cash on you then a \$2 fee will be charged to your account. Please remove all waste from your dog, inside and outside of the facility. There are two dumpsters located on either side of our front door in which you may toss your trash.
- **Please no flexi-leads** inside or outside of our facility. A 4 to 6 foot standard leash is safe for all and ensures you have control over your dog at all times. **If your dog is not reliable off-lead DO NOT let them off-lead.**
- Take care when allowing your dog to meet another. Though we know our dogs very well they are still animals and can be unpredictable, especially in a new place. Exercise caution, and if you are unsure in the slightest, then don't proceed without the assistance of an instructor.
- **We support positive training methods** and our goal is to provide you with the space and the tools to master them. We will not tolerate harsh treatment of dogs in our facility. If your dog is having an off-day, end it on a positive note! Never ask your dog to do something that may cause discomfort or injury. **Setting your dog up for success builds on positive experience!** If your dog gets spooked or injured it can set your progress back significantly.
- **Please use the crates** provided. This ensures safety for all dogs during classes. You are always welcome to bring in your own as well, sometimes dogs find this easier to tolerate in a new place. If you opt to tether your dog please use the anchored floor tethers rather than anything that is not secured down. **Please bring your own bedding** as blankets, crate pads, and the like will not be provided for you.
- **Bring your own water bowls.** Due to safety concerns, we will not provide community dog bowls for water or food. It is important to consider the needs of your dog so please be prepared and bring your own water bowls.
- **Always check online for cancellations.** Classes may skip weeks if there are pre-scheduled facility rentals, trials, or seminars. Though we do our best to contact you about them, you must also be responsible for taking note of it. Most class descriptions will have these skipped dates (if any) included in the description.
